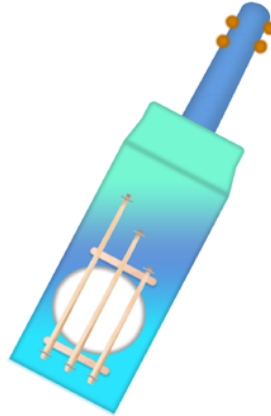




Milk Carton Guitar

Parent Note: Not suitable for children under the age of 3



Materials:

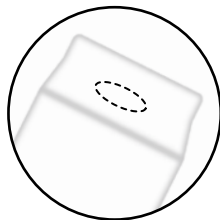
- 1 Prairie Farms Half Gallon Milk Carton
- Paper towel cardboard roll
- Sharp knife or scissors (with help from a parent)
- Construction paper in a variety of colors
- Hot glue gun (with help from a parent)
- 2 popsicle sticks
- 3 rubber bands
- Big stapler and staples
- 4-6 tiny pompoms

Step 1:

Clean out empty carton with soap and water. Discard cap.

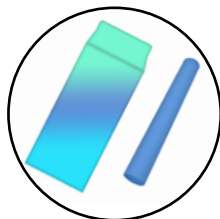
Step 2:

With help from a parent use a knife or box cutter to cut out the plastic spout on top of the carton and discard.



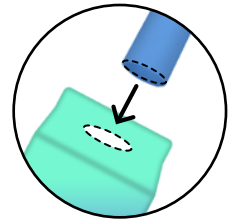
Step 3:

Using hot glue, wrap the milk carton and the paper towel roll in colored construction paper to decorate.



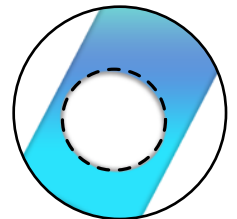
Step 4:

Cut into construction paper and widen the hole from the spout to be the size of the paper towel roll opening and hot glue the paper towel roll and insert into the hole.



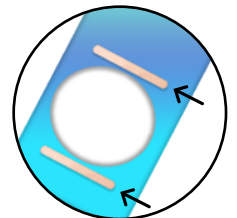
Step 5:

Cut out a large hole on the carton front for the face of the guitar.



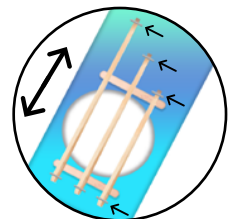
Step 6:

Glue popsicle sticks above and below the hole to create the guitar bridge.



Step 7:

Stretch rubber bands to 3 different lengths and using 6 staples, staple them in place over the hole to make guitar strings.



Step 8:

Glue pompoms on each side of the paper towel to create guitar tuners.
