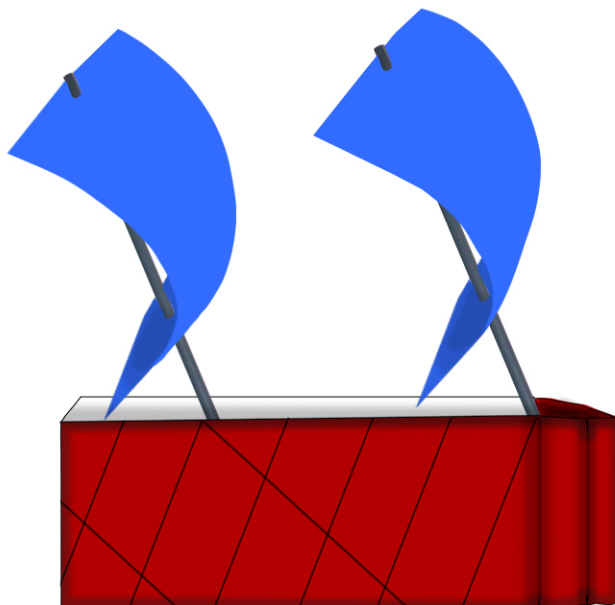




Milk Carton Sailboat

Parent Note: Not suitable for children under the age of 3



Materials:

- 1 Prairie Farms Quart Half & Half Carton
- Scissors (with help from a parent)
- Duct Tape
- Construction Paper
- Drinking Straws
- Hole Puncher

Step 1:

Clean out empty carton with soap and water.

Step 2:

Cut a rectangular side panel out of the empty milk carton (side where the triangle forms up top). This side will be facing up when carton is placed in water.

Step 3:

Cover outside of milk carton in duct tape.

Step 4:

Using scissors, cut the construction paper into equal fourths.

Step 5:

Punch holes in top and bottom of 2 of the pieces of construction paper.

Step 6:

Thread paper through the punch holes with drinking straws to create sails on masts.

Step 7:

Tape straws to inside of milk carton at an angle leaning back.

Step 8:

Place boat in water to watch it float!
